# Chili Contest Official Guidelines

## Official Contestant Guidelines

1. No entry fee for contestants.
2. Ingredients must be listed on a 4x6 card, to ensure originality and to guard against food allergens. Any chili prepared with premixed spice packages will be disqualified.
3. Contestants are responsible for supplying chili in crock pot, slow cooker, with lid. Unit will be labeled with an identifying contestant number to allow for proper recovery.
4. Each contestant will cook and deliver a minimum of 2 quarts of chili.
5. Each contestant will be assigned a contestant number by the chili cook off committee. The contestant's number will be clearly marked on each cup. Each contestant should make sure that they have their assigned number.
6. Contestant entries will be judged by attendees of the Winter Festival. The attendees will pay \$3.00 to sample the different chilis and cast their vote between 12-2:00pm. The winner will be announced before the end of the festival.
7. Contestants may pick up their crock pot at between 2:30-3:00pm.
